

GEOGRAPHICAL PRESENTATIONS

1. Hints:

- Read carefully all the topics and choose one that suits you best.
- Prepare *Power Point* presentation about chosen theme – remember, your team will have exactly **8 minutes** for the presentation.
- Divide work which has to be done among all the participants – you have only **2,5 hours** for completing the task!
- You can use all the materials found in the topic folder, information gathered during the field trips, your own knowledge and information from the internet. Use only trustworthy web-pages.
- Add photos, maps and drawings to make the presentation more attractive but don't forget about the clearness of the slides.
- The presentation has to be **in English!**
- If you would like to prepare your own charts or graphs use *Microsoft Excel* program or *Microsoft Paint*.
- Divide final presentation tasks among **all** participants of the group – e.g. each of you can refer part of the material or you can 'specialize' in the tasks: one will talk, someone else will point at the map.
- In the presentation you can include additional examples from your **home countries**.
- Be sure that you have **saved** last changes in the presentation and **copied** it at your pen-drive.

A) Anthropogenic changes in hydrological system

What should you enclose in the topic:

- Brief information what hydrological system is,
- Theory and examples of human impact on the water-system,
- Examples of human water-management observed during the field trips,
- Multidimensional results of water-management (e.g. functions of the lakes),
- Positive and negative effects of this managing (theory and practice),
- Examples from your home countries.

B) Human and a landscape creation

What you should enclose in the topic:

- Brief information what a landscape is,
- Theory and examples of human impact on the natural landscape,
- Examples of human landscape-management observed during the field trips,
- Results of landscape creation (e.g. anthropogenic reservoirs),
- Positive and negative effects of this creation (theory and practice),
- Examples from your home countries.

C) The future belongs to renewable energy?

What you should enclose in the topic:

- Brief information what renewable energy is,
- Theory and examples of human exploitation of renewable energy sources,
- Examples of usage of renewable energy observed during the field trips,
- Possibilities for extension of renewable energy usage in the region (e.g. new resources, new power plants),
- Problems to be addressed on the way to increase renewable energy usage,
- Examples from your home countries.

D) Cultural landscape as a tourist attraction

What you should enclose in the topic:

- Brief information what cultural landscape is,
- Theory and examples of tourist attraction based on culture,
- Examples of cultural landscape which functions as a tourist attraction observed during the field trips,
- Your ideas of new tourist product based on culture and promotion possibilities,
- Positive and negative effects generated by tourism in reception areas,
- Examples from your home countries.
